**REMEMBER!** Next year, and every school year thereafter, all 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will need to show proof of Tdap vaccination. Let's keep the momentum going strong by following these 3 simple steps:

- ✓ Immunize your patients with Tdap at every opportunity
- ✓ Bring in your 11-12 year olds for the adolescent well-child check up. Make sure your
  office is well stocked with all necessary vaccines (Tdap, Meningococcal, Varicella dose 2,
  HPV, and Influenza)
- ✓ Provide clear documentation of Tdap immunization for your patients to bring to school
