Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccine Updates

AB 499 California Minor Consent for Medical Care

 As of January 1, 2012, minors 12 years and older can consent to preventive services for sexually transmitted diseases without their parents' consent. This includes HPV and hepatitis B vaccinations.

Additionally, the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) now recommends routine vaccination of males ages 11-12 years with HPV4 (Gardasil) administered as a 3-dose series.

- The vaccination series can be started beginning at age 9 years.
- Vaccination is recommended for males aged 13 through 21 years who have not been vaccinated previously or who have not completed the 3-dose series.
- Males aged 22 through 26 years may also be vaccinated.
