Free Public Tdap Vaccination Clinics for 7th – 12th grade students

SFDPH will hold 3 Tdap clinics open to 7th-12th graders. The clinics are scheduled for:

- Saturday, March 19, 2011 at Roosevelt Middle School
- Saturday, May 14, 2011 at John O'Connell High School
- Saturday, August 6, 2011, location TBD

These clinics are in response to the new school immunization law, AB 354 requiring students entering grades 7-12 in the fall of 2011 to show proof of a Tdap shot before being allowed to begin the new school year.

We are actively encouraging students (parents) to go to their doctor for their Tdap shot, as well as other adolescent immunizations (HPV, Meningococcal, Varicella dose 2, and Influenza).

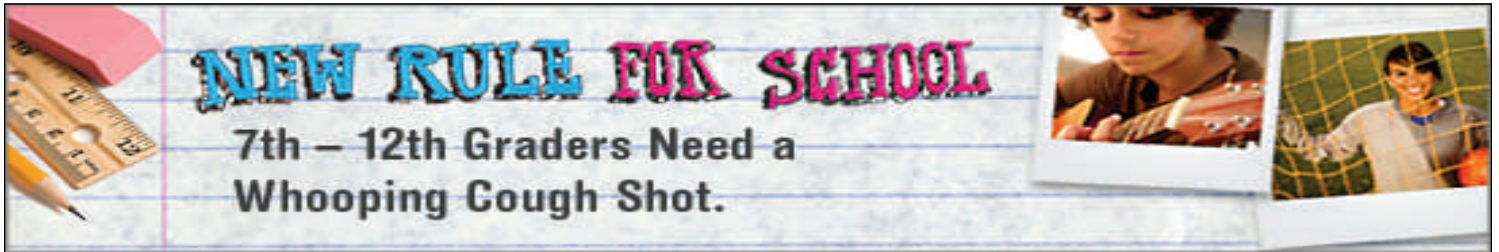
