Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine Approval: Information for Clinicians

December 15, 2020

Situational Update: Pfizer-BioNTech Vaccine

- The <u>Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee</u> (VRBPAC) of the FDA voted to recommend approval of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine (12/10/2020).
- The FDA issued an <u>Emergency Use Authorization</u> (EUA) for the vaccine (12/11/2020).
- The CDC's Advisory Committee on Vaccination Practices (ACIP) confirmed the safety and
 efficacy of the vaccine and issued an <u>interim recommendation</u> for use of the vaccine in
 persons aged >16 years for the prevention of COVID-19 (12/12/2020).
- The <u>Western States Scientific Safety Review Workgroup</u> endorsed the decisions of VRBPAC and ACIP and recommended use of the vaccine in California and other states (12/12/2020).
- The first 12,675 doses of Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine are expected to reach San Francisco this
 week and will be distributed to facilities in accordance with Phase 1A allocation guidelines
 published by the California Department of Public Health. Additional doses are expected to
 arrive during the weeks to follow.

Situational Update: Moderna Vaccine

 A similar cascade of review, approval, and distribution is expected to begin this week for the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, starting with <u>evaluation by VRBPAC on 12/17/2020</u>.
